#### **JOB OVERVIEW:**

To perform a variety of semi-skilled mechanical duties related to the operation of the District's hydroelectric generation facilities, dams, reservoirs, flumes and related facilities; to operate light to heavy construction and maintenance equipment in support of activities related to the construction, maintenance and repair of hydroelectric facilities; and to ensure work is performed in a safe manner. Employees at this level only receive occasional instruction or assistance as new or unusual situations arise and are fully aware of the operating procedures and policies within the work unit.

**Hydroelectric Maintenance Technician II:** Two years of progressively responsible experience in the operation and maintenance of distribution facilities and hydroelectric plant facilities involving the operation of light to heavy construction and maintenance equipment or two years of responsible experience similar to Hydroelectric Technician I with the Nevada Irrigation District.

Equivalent to completion of the twelfth grade supplemented with industrial or construction maintenance coursework, apprenticeship or certification.

**Hydroelectric Maintenance Technician I:** Possession and maintenance of a valid Class A driver's license is required. Possession of certification as a Certified Crane Operator within one year of appointment. Possession of certification as a forklift operator within one year of appointment.
